



CV: Prof. Miodrag Zlatic, D. Sc.

Miodrag Zlatic, D. Sc. is born 21.10.1953 in Belgrade. In 1977 he successfully defended his diploma work at the Faculty of Forestry - Department for Erosion and Meliorations. He is employed at Faculty of Forestry - Department for Ecological Engineering in the Soil and Water Resources Protection (earlier: Department for Erosion and Meliorations) since 1979. He is now the Chief of this Department. Master of Science he successfully defended in 1983 at Faculty of Forestry in Belgrade. Doctoral Dissertation under the environmental and economic justification of erosion control works he successfully defended in 1994 at the Faculty of Forestry in Belgrade. His present position is full professor of Basis of Environmental protection, Erosion Control Economics, Sustainable Natural Resources Management, Natural Resources Policy, Demographic Aspects of Degradation and Protection of Natural resources, Risk and Uncertainty of Investments in Sustainable Land Management. All together he published more than 150 papers from which about 2/3 are scientific papers. He participated at about 40 international conferences and was the chairman and co-chairman of many of them. He was coordinator of several national projects as well as international, from which of great importance for Serbia are following: Regional GEF project: "Community Based Rehabilitation of Degraded Land in Balkan Countries (2004), and "World Overview of Conservation Approaches and Technologies" – (WOCAT) for Serbia (2001-2011). He was editor in chief of the 4 international books/monographies, and is editor in chief of the BULLETIN OF THE FACULTY OF FORESTRY and member of editorial board of several national and international journals. He was the president of the World Association of Soil and Water Conservation (WASWC) for the period: January 2005 – December 2010, and at present is the member of the Council of WASWC as Immediate past president.
